Pursuant to Pennsylvania's Right-to-Know Law, I am submitting this request for public records. Specifically, I am requesting records related to the testing of voting machines from January 1, 2021 (or however far back you think you need to go) to present, as follows:

- A. Records related to the testing of printed ballots, including copies of the ballots tested, and any records which include the date(s), time(s), and location(s) of testing.
- B. Records relating to the testing of voting machines and any records which include the date(s), time(s), and location(s) of testing.
- C. Financial records (i.e. contracts, payment vouchers, and receipts) related to the printing of ballots.
- C. Records indicating the approval of proofs, pertaining to the printing of ballots.
- D. Communications to or from the Election Bureau to Judges of Elections regarding the procedures to manually tabulate unscanned ballots.
- E. Communications pertaining to reports of ballot malfunctions.

For purposes of this request, "communications" shall mean written correspondence, memoranda, emails, telephone records, texts and chats strings from virtual meetings (e.g. Zoom or Teams meetings).

I do not wish to review the records first and I ask that the records be provided to me in the most cost-effective media (i.e. electronic form). If you have any questions about this request, please do not hesitate to contact me for any needed clarification.
